Registration Instructions for the 2018 BBYRA Championship Series

07 April 2018

Dear BBYRA Sailor,

Welcome to the BBYRA's 2018 Season! Our 10 week Championship Series begins this year on Saturday June 23rd, with Bay Head and Metedeconk River Yacht Clubs co-hosting at Mantoloking Yacht Club.

2018 CHAMPIONSHIP RACING SERIES REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Please note the following with regard to the registration forms, information, and process:

Registration: The 2018 Registration Form is available along with these registration instructions on the BBYRA website (<http://www.bbyra.org>) located in the section entitled "Championship Series". Refer to the Fee Schedule on page 3 of these instructions.

Available again for 2018! ONLINE SEASON REGISTRATION. Boats are strongly encouraged to register **ONLINE** for the **season** via the BBYRA website (www.bbyra.org), using a major credit card.

Open the section entitled "Championship Series" and then the tab for "Season Registration". Fill out the form, select your payment method and then click "Continue". If the field entries were valid you will be directed to payment and your registration will be confirmed. If paying by check don't forget to mail your payment!

Junior registrations are available for all fleets at 50% off by entering PROMO Code "JUNIOR" and hitting the "APPLY" button on the registration form. Junior registrations are only for junior skippers with all junior crews.

If registering for more than one fleet, separate registrations will need to be completed. For multiple registrations the system requires a different email address for each registration. You can just add a number in front of your regular email address for subsequent

registrations if you don't care about a confirmation email and you don't want multiple email copies when contacted.

Registering Online should prove MUCH easier for all sailors, and the scorer too! Please give it a try.

No late fees will apply at any time for online registrations.

MAIL-IN REGISTRATION. Boats may register for the **season** by **mail** before June 13, 2018. A printable form is available under the "NOR-SIs" tab for "Championship Series". You may return the completed Registration Form by US Mail to the address shown above along with your appropriate Fees, check payable to "BBYRA Season Registration". Late fees will apply to mail-in registrations received after June 13, 2018.

IN PERSON REGISTRATION. Boats may register for the Season in person each race day at the Regatta Headquarters. Late fees will apply. Season Registration will not be accepted on the water.

DAILY REGISTRATION. Boats may register for "Daily" participation on each race day with the prescribed race fees at the Regatta Headquarters or on the water, either at the "Late Entry" boat for the GREEN COURSE or the Race Committee "Start" Boat for the ROSE COURSE. The Daily Registration fee is per "race". If a boat sails any portion of the Season as a "Daily" registrant and then subsequently registers for the Season, those daily fees paid up to that time will **not** be credited toward its Season Registration fee.

Races for Qualification: In order to qualify for the Championship a boat must come to the starting area on at least 50% of race days scheduled for her class.

Skipper: Throughout our forms and documents, the use of the word "Skipper" means "person in charge", who must be on board while racing (see RRS 46).

BBYRA Junior Awards and Trophies: For any awards and trophies designated for "Juniors", a registering skipper must have been born after 1998.

Crew Awards: Crew awards will be given with trophies for applicable classes.

Course Sheets: Season Registrants are entitled to a set of Tyvek Course Sheets that are available at the registration desk each week while supplies last.

Barrel Courses: Competitors are advised to review the barrel courses and associated starting areas on the course maps posted on the BBYRA website <http://www.bbyra.org/championship.shtml#sj> **Please note: There will be just a single upwind Finish Boat and Finish Line serving both portable and fixed mark courses when either or both of those courses finish upwind (Refer to Sailing Instructions for further details).**

Rules: Please note that the BBYRA Championship Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the Sailing Instructions, the NOR and class rules as applicable by fleet.
